

Connecticut's Current Flu Immunization Laws and Regulation

Dear Parents,

All children attending St. Thomas & St. Timothy School must be in compliance with the current immunization laws and regulations. The State of Connecticut Department of Public Health requires that **children aged 6-59 months who attend a licensed child care program and children aged 24-59 months who attend school must receive 1 dose of flu vaccination between August 1st and December 31st (2 doses separated by at least 28 days required for those receiving flu vaccine for the first time) in order to stay in school.**

Therefore, no St. Thomas & St. Timothy School student under 5 will be permitted to come to school after the December winter break without proof of flu vaccination. The child may not re-enter school until the requirement is fulfilled or until the end of the flu season, March 31, 2023.

Please submit your documentation to the nurse by **December 22, 2023**, our last full day of school before the December winter break. Please contact the nurse with any questions or concerns.
