## Student Cell Phone, Electronic Readers, and Movie Permission Form 2016-2017

### MOVIES

Occasionally we will show movies for assemblies or in the classrooms. We will only show movies that are G, PG, or PG-13 rated. (The school will always make the titles of the movies available to the students in advance in case there is a movie that you don't want your child to see. Just send a note along and we will make sure that your child is allowed to skip the movie.)

### ELECTRONIC READERS

I give permission for my child, \_\_\_\_\_ to bring a Nook, Kindle, etc. (I Pads are still not allowed for student use) for reading books at school. By signing this permission slip I release St. Timothy Middle School from any responsibility for damage or theft or any other unforeseen consequence of bringing the device to school. Although the school allows students to bring these devices it is not recommended. These devices are expensive and there is a potential risk that they may get broken or misplaced in a school environment.

- Students must let teachers know that they will be using an electronic book.
- Students must get approval of the book from the teacher.
- If use of the device becomes a distraction for others, the teacher may ask the student to stop using it and leave it at home.
- The device is to be used only for reading books. Any other use must be approved by the principal.

### CELL PHONES

I am aware that St. Timothy Middle School collects all student cell phones each morning and returns them to the students at the end of the day. Students are not allowed to keep cell phones in their desks or backpacks during the day.
